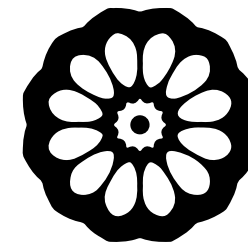
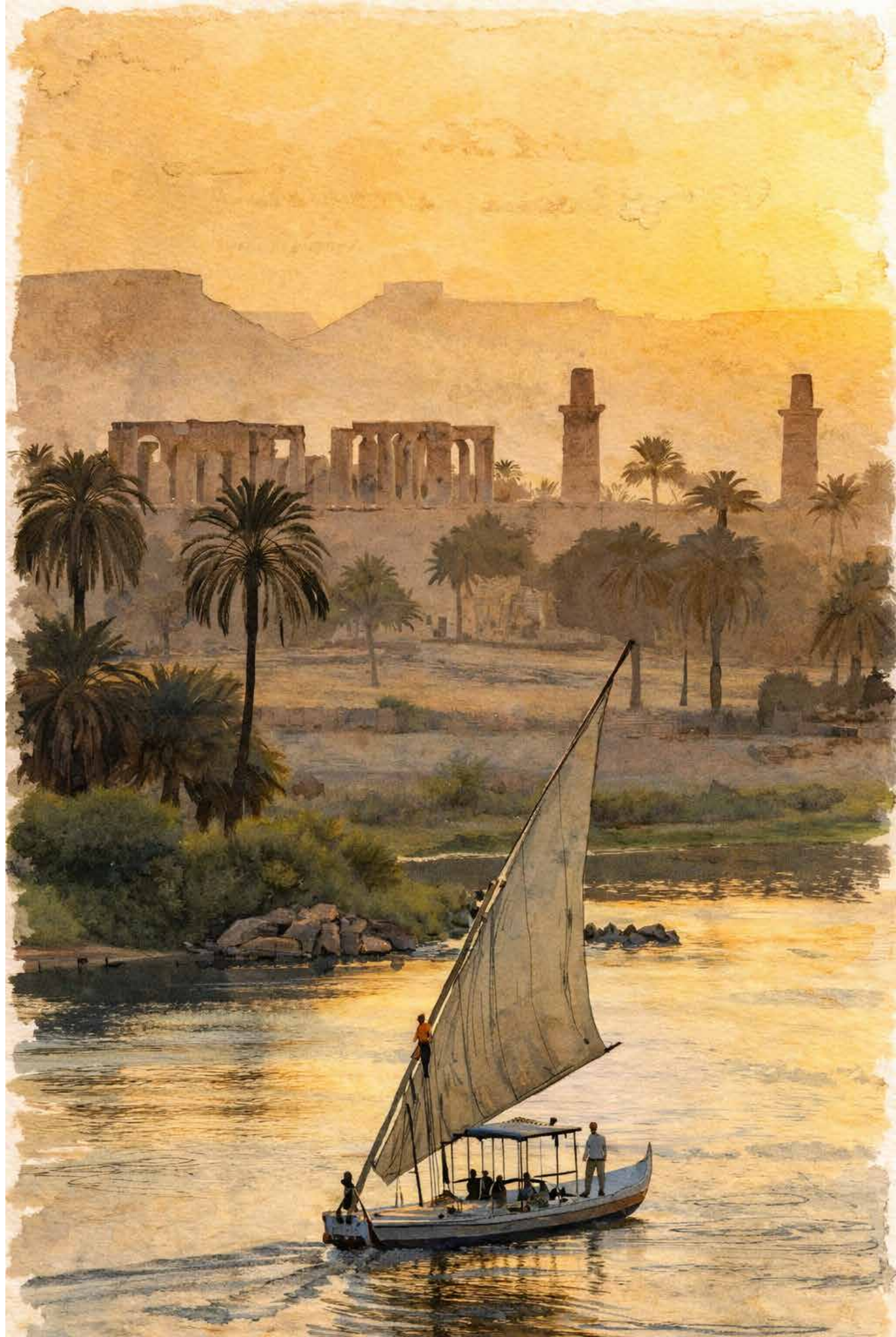




THE GRAND MANDARIN

seamless service come together.

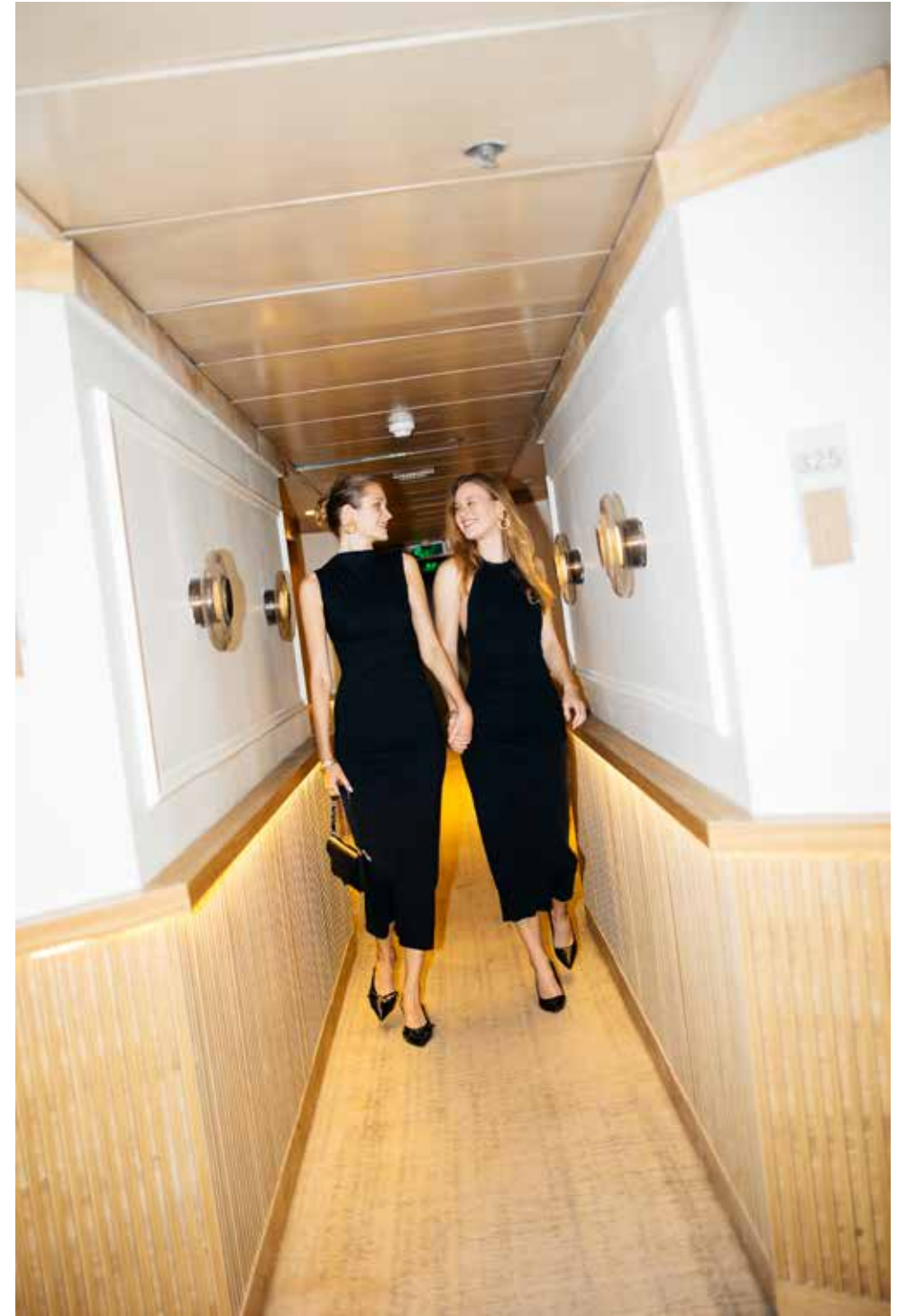
From welcoming social spaces to private

THE RECEPTION

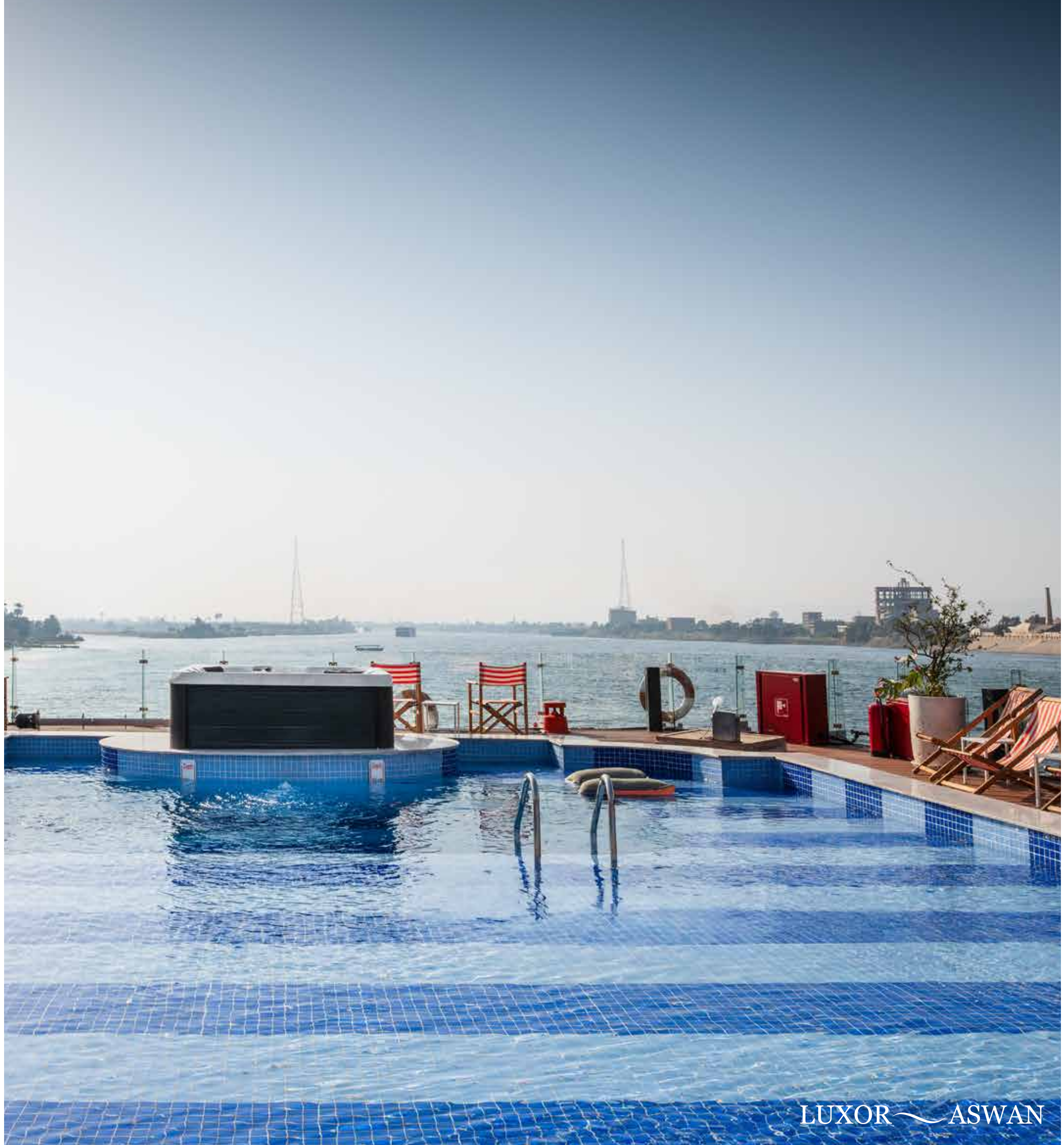


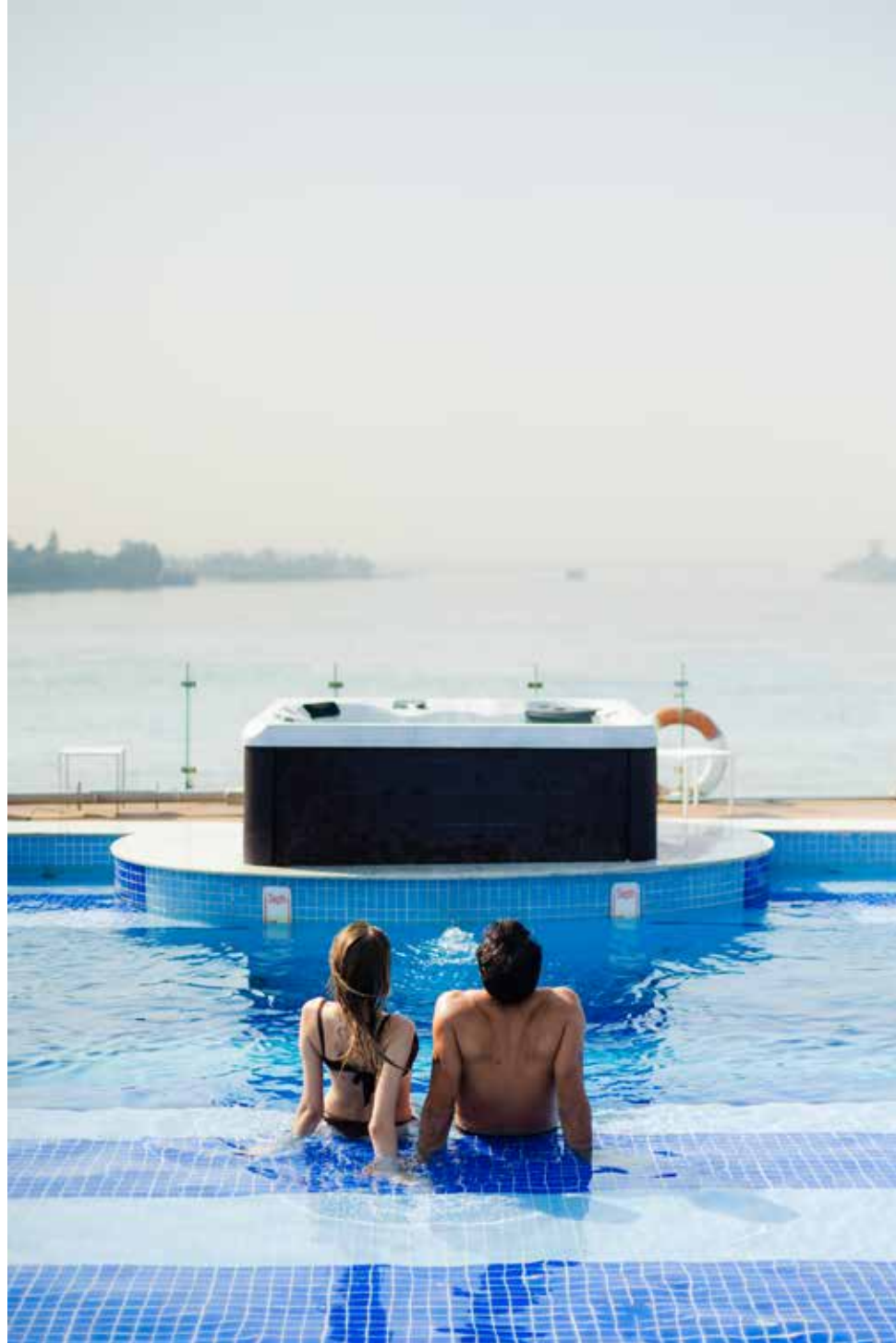


THE SUN DECK

DAY 1 — LUXOR (EMBARKATION & EAST BANK)

- Embarkation & Lunch: Board the cruise and enjoy a welcome lunch onboard.
- Excursions: Explore the East Bank of the Nile, including visits to the Karnak Temple and Luxor Temple.
- Evening: Return to the cruise for dinner and overnight stay in Luxor.



DAY 2 — LUXOR TO EDFU (WEST BANK & SAILING)

- Morning Excursions: After breakfast, visit key sites on the West Bank of the Nile:
(Valley of the Kings - Temple of Queen Hatshepsut at Deir El-Bahari - Colossi of Memnon)
- 12:00 PM Sailing
- 1:00 PM: Depart Luxor and sail toward Esna Lock; lunch served onboard
- 6:30 PM: Arrive at Esna, cross the lock, and continue sailing to Edfu
- Evening: Dinner onboard and overnight stay in Edfu



DAY 3 — EDFU TO KOM OMBO TO ASWAN

- 7:00 AM: Visit the Temple of Horus in Edfu, one of Egypt's best-preserved ancient temples. Sail to Kom Ombo.
- 9:30 AM: Resume sailing with lunch served onboard
- 4:30 PM: Arrive at Kom Ombo and tour the twin temple dedicated to Sobek and Haroeris
- 6:00 PM: Continue sailing to Aswan with dinner onboard
- 11:30 PM: Arrive in Aswan; overnight stay on the cruise



DAY 4 — ASWAN

- 7:00 AM: Visit key landmarks in Aswan: (Temple of Philae - The High Dam - Old Aswan Dam)
- 12:00PM: Lunch onboard.
- 3:00 PM: Felucca ride around Elephantine Island and the Botanical Garden
- Evening: Dinner and overnight stay onboard in Aswan

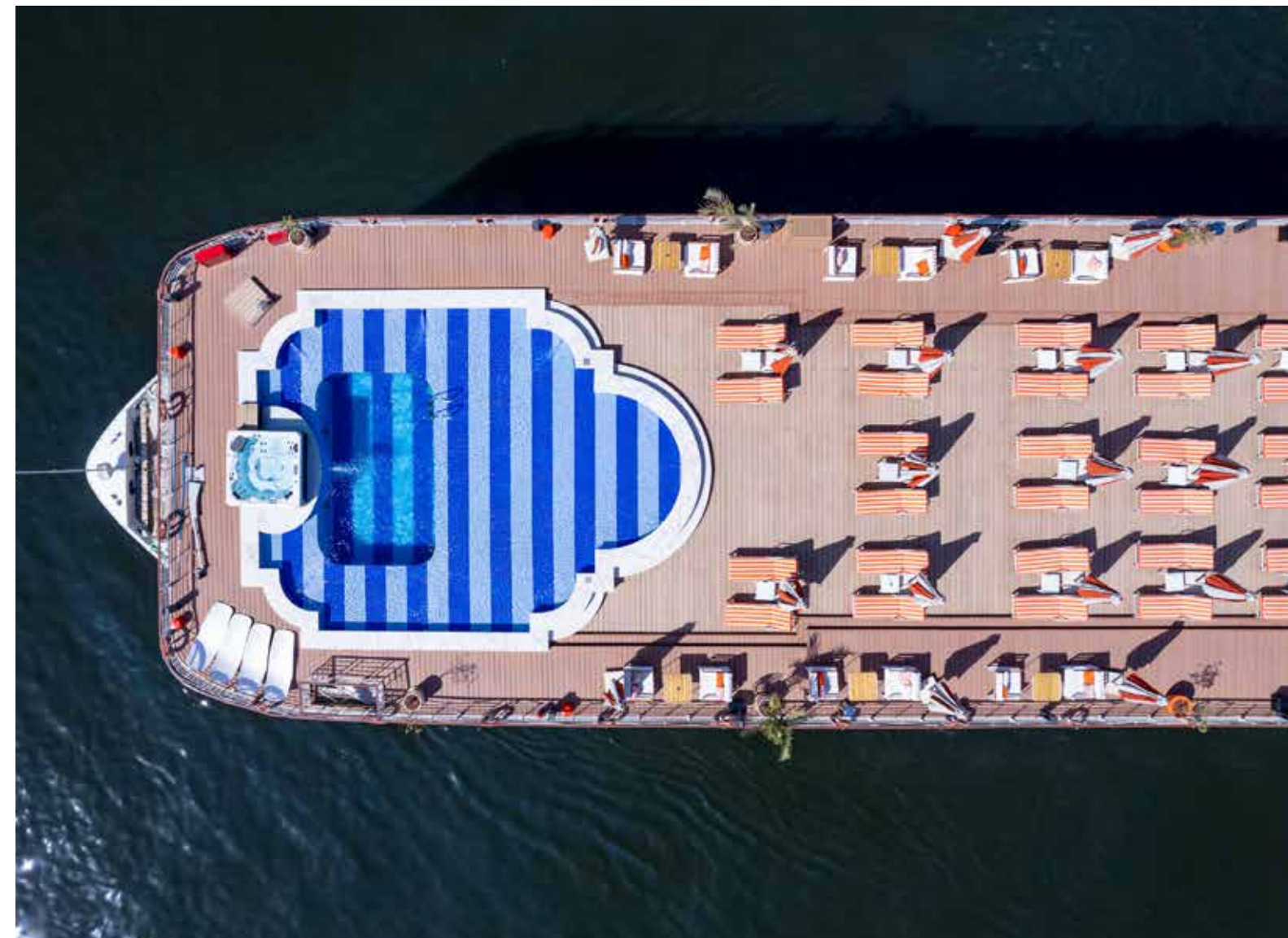


DAY 5 — ASWAN (DISEMBARKATION)

The schedule and sailing times are subject to change due to circumstances beyond the cruise's control. However, all listed visits and excursions will be accommodated accordingly.



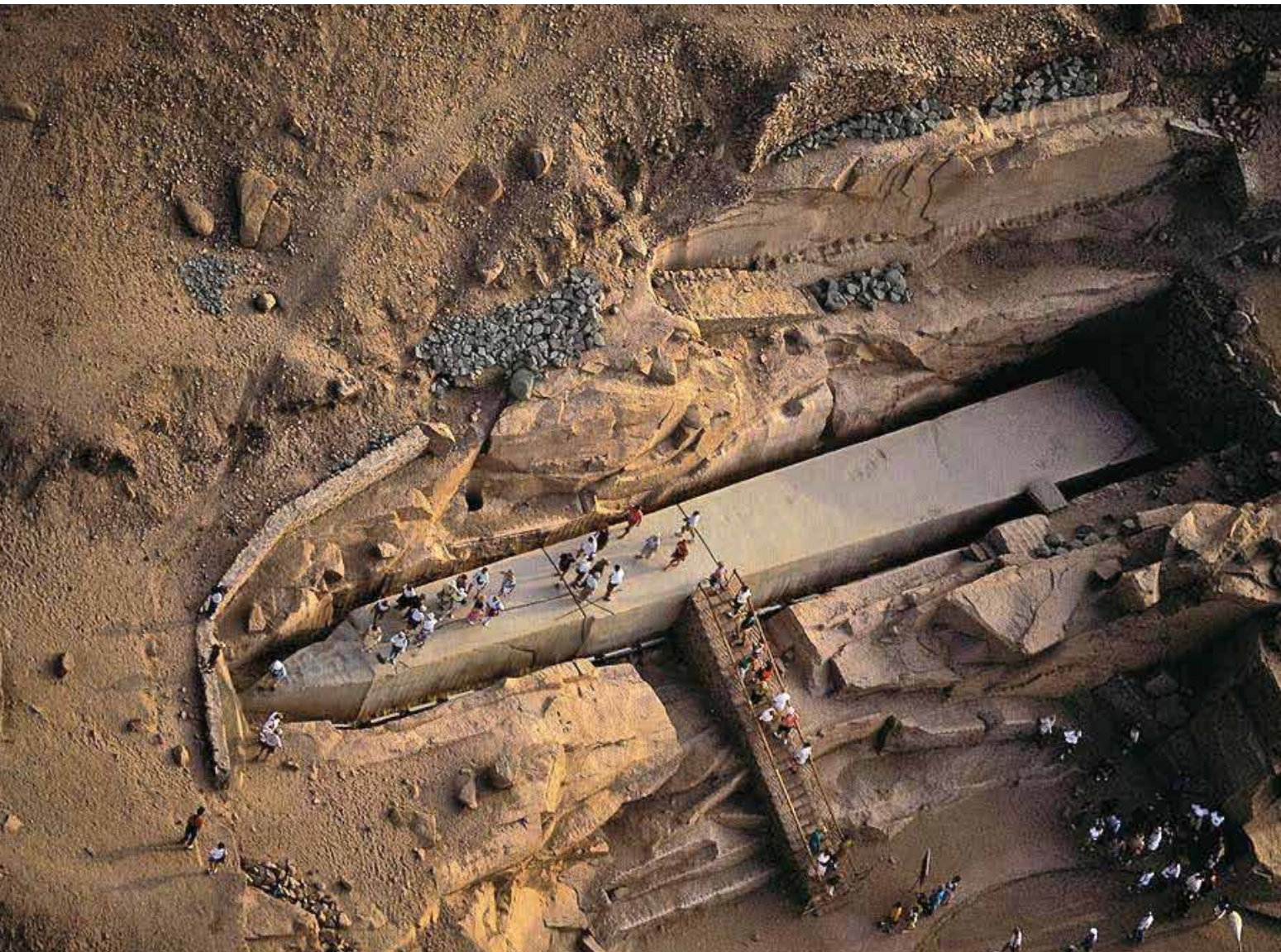

DAY 1 — ASWAN (EMBARKATION & EXCURSIONS)

- Board the cruise and enjoy lunch onboard Visit key attractions in Aswan:
Temple of Philae - The Unfinished Obelisk
- Dinner and overnight stay onboard in Aswan



DAY 2 — ASWAN TO KOM OMBO TO EDFU

- After breakfast, complete your Aswan tour with visits to: (The High Dam - The Old Dam of Aswan)
- 1:30 PM: Begin sailing to Kom Ombo with lunch onboard
- 4:30 PM: Visit the Temple of Kom Ombo, dedicated to Sobek and Haroeris
- 6:30 PM: Continue sailing to Edfu with dinner onboard
- 10:30 PM: Arrive in Edfu; overnight stay onboard



DAY 3 — EDFU TO ESNA TO LUXOR

- 7:00 AM: Visit the Temple of Edfu, dedicated to the god Horus. Sail to Luxor via Esna Lock.
- 9:00 AM: Depart for Esna Lock
- 12:00 PM: Cross the lock while enjoying lunch onboard, then continue sailing to Luxor.
Dinner onboard and overnight stay in Luxor.
- 11:00 PM: Arrival



DAY 4 — LUXOR (DISEMBARKATION & EXCURSIONS)

- Enjoy breakfast onboard before leaving the cruise
- Visit the West Bank of the Nile, including: (Valley of the Kings - Temple of Queen Hatshepsut at Deir El-Bahari - Colossi of Memnon)
